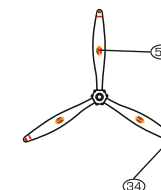

 late 1939

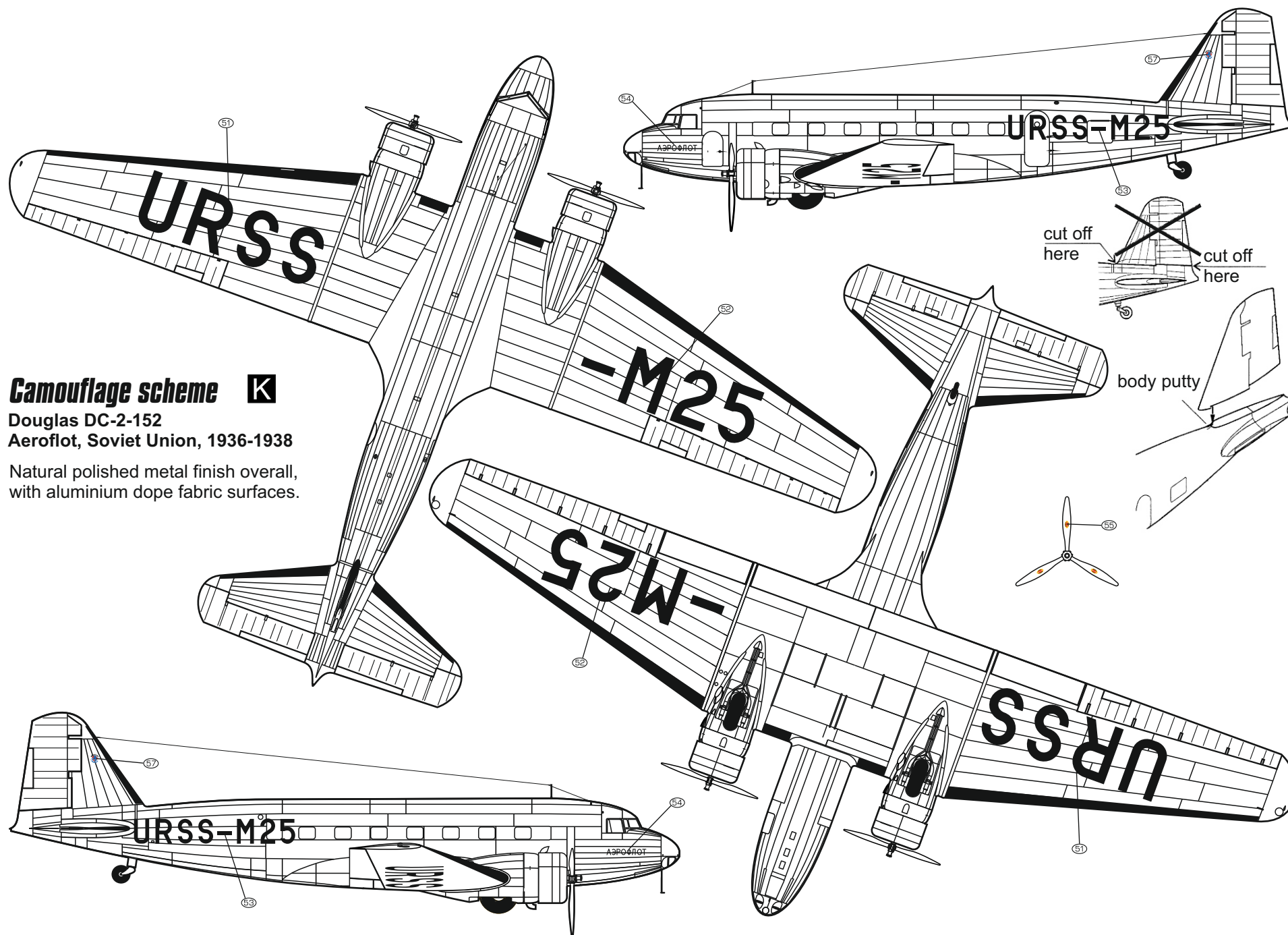
