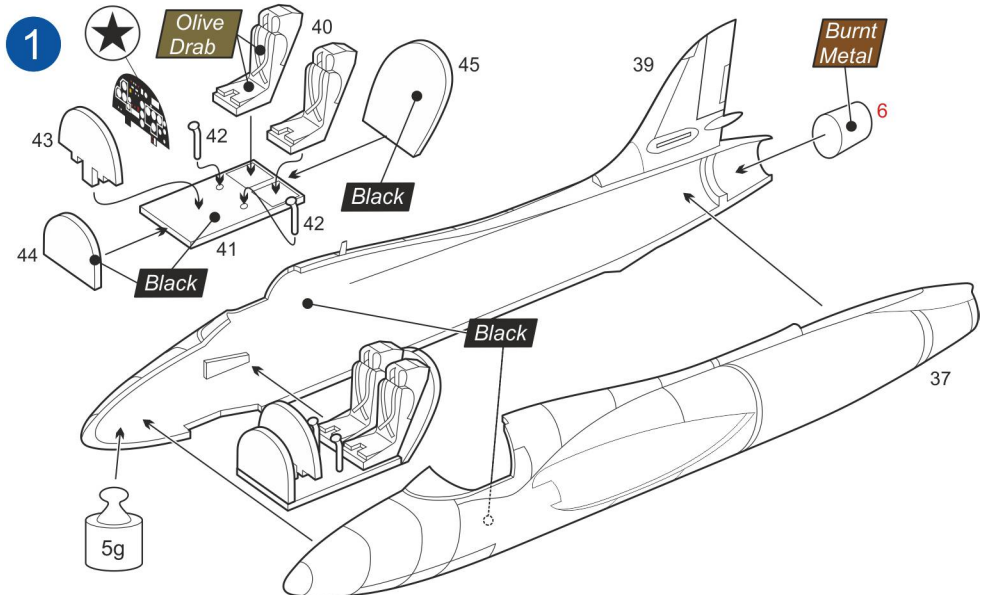

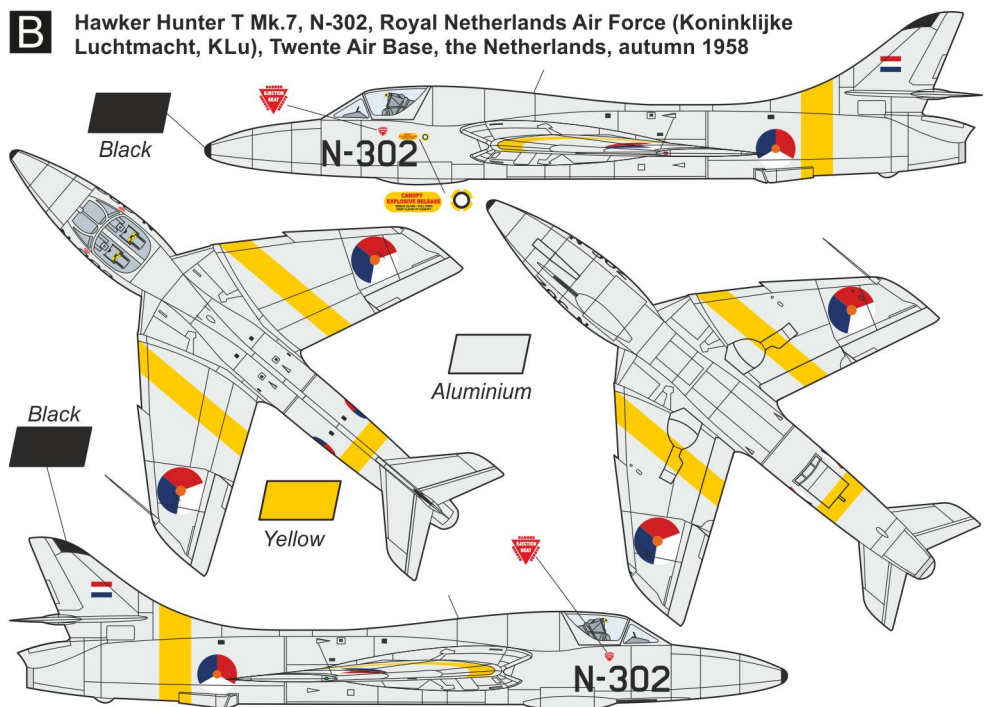
Main undercarriage & pylons position



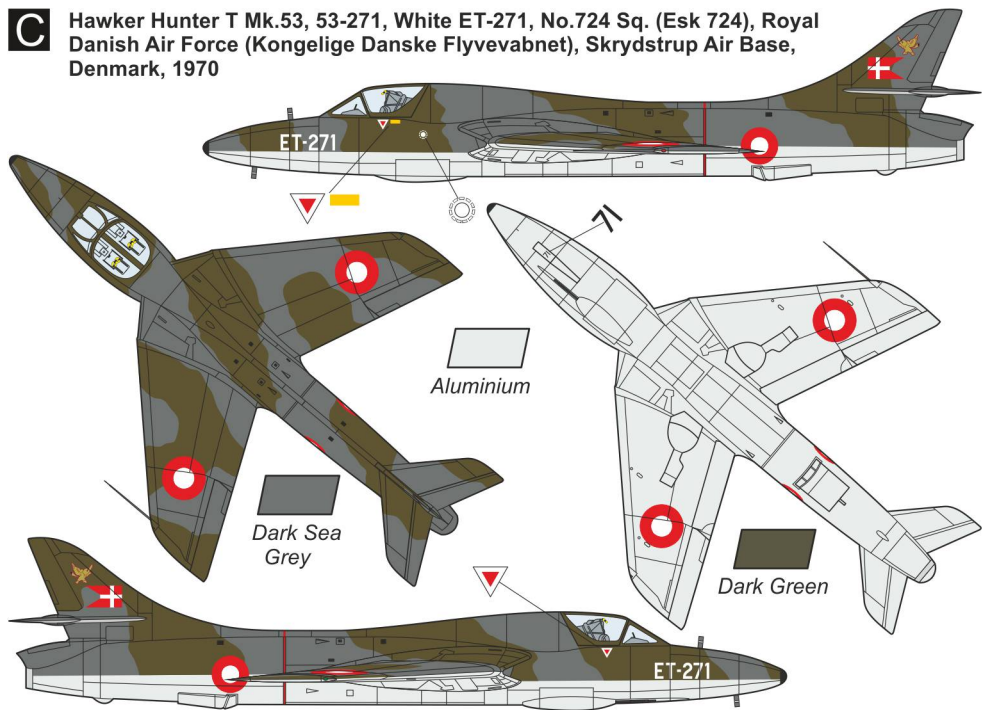
